Guidelines for entries

- Lydiard Millicent Village Show is a community event designed to encourage people to share their creativity with others. It is run by amateurs, for amateurs. The judges are not usually professionals, although they do have some expertise in the classes they judge.

- Each item entered will cost £1 for adults and 50p for children. Any profits made will go towards the village community. Group entries cost £1. Children's group entries cost 50p.

- There are no prizes, but rosettes will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd places.

- With the exception of the children's classes, and the men-only baking class, entries can be made by anyone of any age or ability.

- We ask that all the children's work is their own.

- Please do not put your name visibly on your exhibits.

- Due to a lack of display space, we ask that you keep to the size guidelines.

- The deadline for writing class entries (G28, G29, G30) is **30th April 2018.** Please leave a hardcopy with your entry form and additionally email your entry to *lydiardmillicentvillageshow@gmail.com*

- All other entries should be presented at the Parish Hall between 9-11am on 7th May 2018.

Judging will take place from 11am-1.30pm, and the hall and the church will be open to the public from 2-4pm, when refreshments will be available. There will be no presentations this year. Winning rosettes will be affixed to entry cards. We ask that you leave these on your exhibit until at least 3.30pm. We will make sure they get to you after the Show.
All entry forms, including all submissions for writing classes, must be in by Friday 30th April 2018.

- Up to 4 people can enter using the same entry form, as long as they live at same address.
